Qualification Approach and Plan

- Most significant comments received from version 0.1:
 - Request to prioritise Suppliers with larger volume of Metering Systems when allocating tranches to enable them to be able to meet migration milestones- BSC legal advice has confirmed that this would not be in line with current BSC requirements for MHHS Qualification
 - Request to bring forward tranche allocation activity- Code Bodies then consulted with participants and this was not a majority view based on responses
- Future Iterations:
 - Further versions of the plan will be developed in line with SIT dependencies for Qualification



May 2023

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1. Role of IPA

The MHHS Programme has applied a '3 Lines of Defence' assurance model (First line - Assurance by individual party, Second line - Assurance by Central Programme Team, PMO & PPC and Third line - Independent Assurance). This is a widely used assurance model that creates independence between programme delivery and operation of programme controls; and the review of effective delivery and operation of those controls to build transparency and confidence in overall delivery. The IPA will operate as the 'Third Line of Defence' to provide confidence to key stakeholders including Ofgem, the Elexon SRO, and wider industry. IPA reports to SRO and Ofgem and the PSG.

1. Assurance Activities To-date

To-date we have been involved with assurance activities relating to the following theme based (providing ongoing theme-based assurance and input to the programme) and stages based (Providing an early view of readiness and supporting corrective action prior to key milestone decisions) activities:



Test Assurance P1 Report & Key Exam Questions - DRAFT

For P1, the IPA Assurance is targeted at two key exam questions:

• Is the programme on track to complete PIT Functional?

• Is the programme on track to start SIT-CIT?

Supporting evidence - Participant Sample:

- A. Do the sampled participants have sufficient detail on what they need to do to execute and complete PIT? E.g. are the timelines clear, are the reporting requirements clear, is the scope clear, etc.
- B. Do the sampled participants have sufficient detail on what they need to do to be ready for CIT? E.g. are the timelines clear, are the environment requirements clear, are the data requirements clear, etc.
- C. Are the sampled participants plans for PIT and CIT aligned with the timelines and the milestones shared by SI?
- D. Are the sampled participants on track for PIT and CIT? Are there any 'blocking issues'?

Supporting evidence - Programme:

- E. Are the programme's plans for PIT execution and completion and CIT preparation reasonable? Do they include the areas expected e.g. data, environments, test cases, test governance etc.
- F. Does the SI/LDP have a good internal plan covering their activities in relation to PIT exit and CIT preparation?
- G. Does the SI/LDP have sufficient and appropriate resources in place?
- H. Has the programme appropriately considered the risks to PIT and CIT and made appropriate accommodations to minimise their impact/likelihood?
- I. Is it clear how the Programme's Placing Reliance Policy will be applied during PIT and CIT?
