Recommendation on approval of milestone T2-TE-0600	The Programme advised the draft MHHS-DEL2257 SIT Component Integration Testing Test Completion Report v0.6 was issued to the SITAG on 23 February 2024 and again on 04 March 2024 with no comments returned by SITAG members. The Programme informed SITAG members the Fast Track Implementation Group (FTIG) provided a recommendation the report be approved on 08 March 2024. The Chair invited any objections to the approval of the report and completion of Programme milestone T2-TE-0600 (SIT Component Integration	
	Testing Test Completion Report Approved), to which none were raised.	
	The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the CIT Test Completion Report completion of milestone T2-TE-0600 (DECISION SITAG-DEC10 – recording timestamp 00:04:38).	

Recommendation on approval of milestone T3-TE-0034	The IPA advised that overall, based on their assurance activities, they support the recommendation that SIT F commences as of 11 Ma 2024. The IPA noted the outstanding work-off items carry a level of risk, but sufficient progress had been made to support the success commencement of SIT F. The Elexon Representative advised they are still to receive the testing schedule. The Programme advised the test ordering had been updation ADO and was visible to the cohorts, and a bilateral discussion was scheduled with the Elexon Helix team on 11 March 2024 where a guestions could be raised.	
Work-Off Plans	from FTIG that the milestone be approved. The Chair invited any comments from SITAG members, to which none were raised. The Ofgem Representative asked how momentum on the resolution of any remaining work-off items would be maintained. The Programme advised monitoring would be undertaken via the FTIG, and weekly updates provided.	
	The Programme noted the acceptance criteria for T2-TE-0550 had been met, and advised any remaining work-off activities did not prevent SIT F commencement. Updates on work-off progress were provided to the FTIG on 08 March 2024, and a recommendation provided by FTIG that Programme milestone T3-TE-0034 (SIT Functional Testing Start) be approved. The Programme provided an overview of the T3-TE-0034 decision choreography and acceptance criteria, noting the recommendation received	
	The RECCo Representative asked whether all CCPs are PIT complete, with code deployed and data loaded. The Programme the position or PIT completion was positive, with written confirmation received from CCPs they are PIT complete. The Programme are awaiting completion PIT reports from Licensed Distribution service Operators (LDSOs), and code deployment and data loaded completion for all central parties has been completed.	
	The Ofgem Representative commented it was positive the SIT F start date had been preserved and asked when the two cohorts sched to commence later would be confirmed. The Programme advised the commencement of these cohorts was predicated on the relevant D and metering service providers completing PIT to sufficient quality, and the Programme has worked with participants to confirm 25 Ma 2024 as the scheduled start date. Confirmation of PIT completion is expected by 22 March 2024.	
	Regarding other readiness activities, the Programme advised the test management information data model was in place, and reporting te based on sample data. All test case data has been loaded into the Azure DevOps (ADO) and quality checks undertaken on reports which the data. Subject to the approval of SIT F commencements, the first test reports will be issued 13 March 2024. Three participants H outstanding activities relating to connectivity, and there is high confidence these will be resolved by week two of SIT F when relevant tests due to commence. Code deployment and data loading is now complete and all parties have confirmed they are able to access ADO and cases are loaded.	
	The Programme provided updates on SIT preparation work-off progress and SIT Functional (SIT F) readiness per the meeting slides, advising confirmation had been received from Core Capability Providers (CCPs) that central systems will be available for SIT F commencement. The Programme advised four SIT F cohorts are confirmed as ready to start. Two cohorts are awaiting Data Service Providers (DSPs) to be PIT complete and are scheduled to commence on 25 March 2024 as notified to SITAG on 21 February 2024. A further two will commence later once outstanding documentation has been submitted and assured. The Programme advised affected cohorts and the FTIG had been briefed.	

The Chair invited any objections to the completion of Programme milestone T3-TE-0034 and approval of SIT F start, to which none were received.	
The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the SRO, approved the completion of T3-TE-0034 and approval of SIT F start (DECISION SITAG-DEC11 – recording timestamp 00:20:40).
