



CR036 Appeal Decision: IPA advised they had not seen evidence that overturning the original CR036 decision outweighed the impacts of doing so. Recommendations on improvements to the Programme change process have been provided to the Programme and the IPA recommend a wider industry review of the discrepancies in the use of UTC/Clock Time.





Many comments were requests for clarification.

We did:

- Where required, updates have been made to the QA&P to clarify position and a redlined version is provided alongside.

You said:

Concerns raised by Non-SIT Suppliers and Agents on provision of PIT Completion Report (PCR) two months ahead of QT start.

We did:

- We have amended the position to encourage parties to submit their PCR two months ahead of QT Start but moved the final date for submission to one month ahead of QT.
- Parties to be aware that early submission reduces risk of delay to QT start if issues found within the PCR that require additional testing/Work-Off Plans to be agreed with Code Bodies.
- Code Bodies will respond to PCR within a month of submission.



You said:

Concerns raised by Non-SIT Suppliers and Agents on compressed QT completion timescales.

We did:

- 1. Participants will have c. 4.5 months to complete QT.
- Where a participant is at risk of slippage against its QT Plan, Code Bodies will engage and work with them to rebaseline that plan.
- 3. We are working with the Programme to provide reporting on participant progress through Qualification so that this can be used to support Migration planning and confidence that participants will be Qualified by M14.

Summary of Annex 1 QA&P consultation responses

68 comments received from **13 organisations**. 32 comments resulted in updates to the document. The below table provides high level view of common themes and how they were addressed. Updating the Programme Plan

- Currently the baseline programme plan is not aligned to Qualification POAPs. Code Bodies and MHHSP are
 working together to update the programme plan.
- QA&P and Annexes are in line with updated timeline rather than programme plan
- The proposed high-level changes are:
 - Update milestones to new wave approach rather than tranches
 - Amending terminology to wave rather than tranche
 - Removal of tranche 5 to 7
 - Amending LDSO QT start date to 1 Oct
 - Refresh of milestones tracking readiness to make sure there are appropriate and tracking the right activities

Two change requests have been raised to manage the changes to the programme plan. The dates in the CR consider the feedback from QAG.



Approval of this milestone finalises the LDSO cohort for QT in Q4.

MHHSP and Code Bodies have worked together to confirm the participant LDSOs in scope for Non-SIT LDSO Qualification Testing. This includes all existing DNOs (5) and iDNOs (12) in the market who are not participating in SIT.

5 new entrants LDSO who are currently progressing through BAU REC and BSC qualification and therefore expected to active in the market ahead of M10.

MHHSP has start to engage with new entrant iDNOs to make them aware of the programme and qualification testing timelines.

MHHSP and Code Bodies will work together to understand progress of new entrant iDNOs through BAU REC and BSC qualification over the coming months to ensure their joining the non-SIT LDSO QT cohort remains an appropriate route to qualification.

 confirmed approach to plan for the delivery of.






