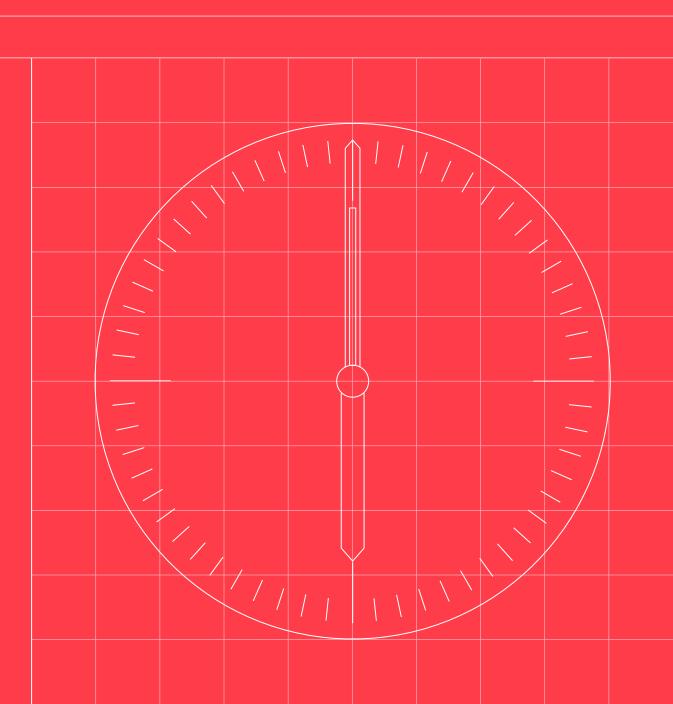

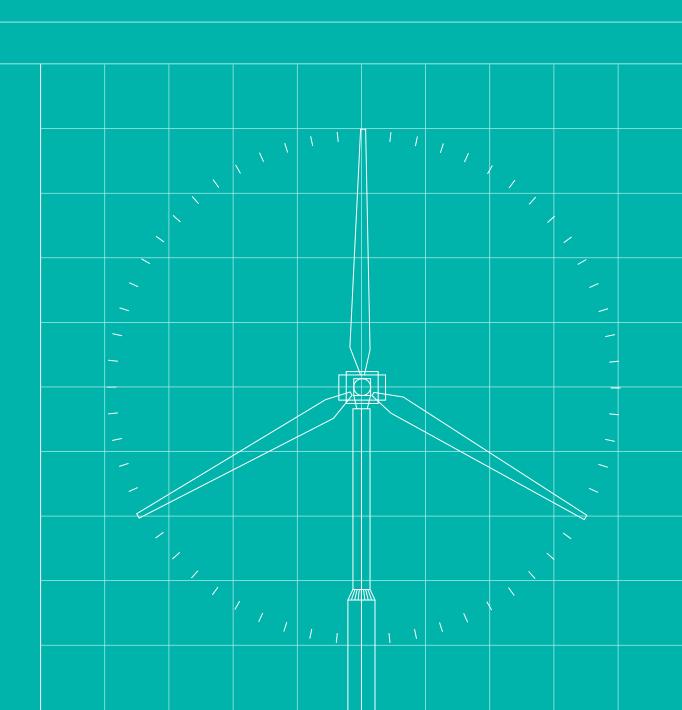

#### **Programme Steering Group (PSG)**

#### Update from PSG 04 May 2022

- 1. CR001 and CR002 Change Requests The Programme presented next steps for CR001 including on the design and Programme re-plan (CR001 (Design Baseline Replan to July 2022) was approved by Ofgem on 21 April 2022, and CR002 (Design Baseline Replan to November 2022) rejected)
- 2. Readiness Assessment An update was provided on the outputs of Readiness Assessment 1, which seeks to assess industry parties' progress with mobilising work to implement MHHS. A lessons learned exercise was also undertaken.
- **3. CR005** the PSG approved CR005 (Programme Ways of Working and Cooperation Principles). These will now be updated in the MHHS Governance Framework
- 4. Open Day Highlights The PSG reviewed feedback from industry parties following the MHHS Open Day Held 21 April 2022. Key messages from the Programme included participants being urged to become involved in the post M5 replan and to mobilise teams prior to the release of the design baseline to de-risk their internal programmes. #### **Cross-Code Advisory Group (CCAG)**

#### **Update from CCAG 23 April 2022**

- CR003 The CCAG reviewed Impact Assessment responses for <u>CR003</u> (<u>CAG proposals to move M6 and M7</u>). It was determined the change should be recommended for approval to Ofgem.
- 2. Code Drafting Principles and Approach The CCAG is developing a detailed plan for the approach code drafting. The primary codes affected are the Retail Energy Code (REC) and the Balancing and Settlement Code (BSC). The current plan anticipates it will take nine to ten months to undertake code drafting and CCAG have begun to define the topic areas and stages of review/consultation required. The CCAG have developed a series of draft principles to assist in guiding this work, which will be presented to DAG for comment.
- 3. Data Service Provider The CCAG have initiated consideration of how data services should be governed, given parties providing such services will be required to undertake qualification.
- 4. SEC MP162 Implications for MDR The Data Communications Company (DCC) requested advice on how the Meter Data Retrieval (MDR) service should be described in the Smart Energy Code. The CCAG agreed this should be defined as "The BSC service that retrieves metering data for the purposes of MHHS"

#### **Design Advisory Group (DAG)**

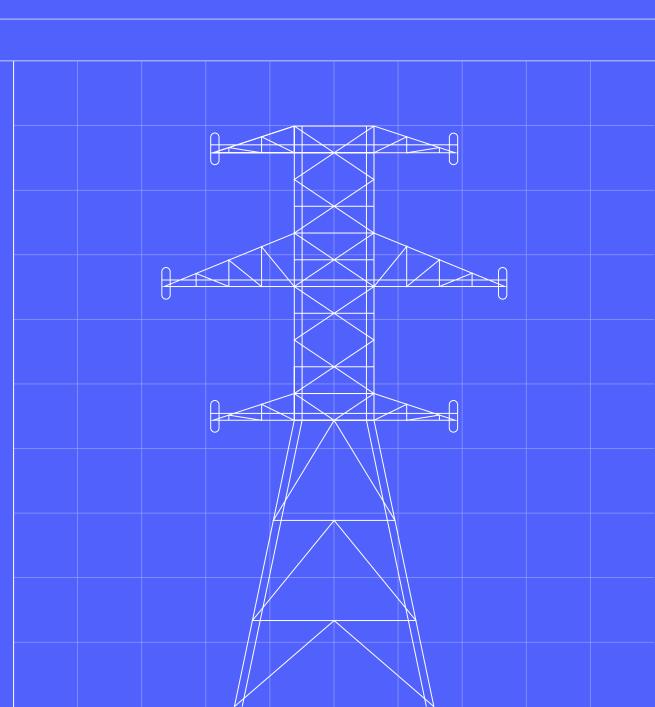
- 1. Tranche 1 design artefacts The Tranche 1 design artefacts have been submitted for approval following the review cycles undertaken via the BPRWG
- 2. DIP The DIP Functional Spec and Non-Functional Requirements documents are also coming for approval following updates by the Programme based on feedback from participants
- 3. Review cycles Updates will be provided on the design artefact review cycle, with Tranche 2 documents to be published to DAG members for review this week, and Tranches 3 & 4 to come to DAG for approval in July
- **4. CCIAG** The group will review the CCIAG draft ToR and make a decision on commencement of the group
- 5. RAID The group will also review the high level themes within the RAID, with a more in depth review in June once the RAID is made publicly available

### Test Data Strategy

The DWG on 05 May 2022 gave an "in principle" recommendation for the Test Data Strategy to be approved by TMAG

#### The recommendation was subject to:

- 1. Resolution of small number of questions
- 2. Incorporation into the revised document of the comments made
- 3. Adding residual issues to the "list of outstanding points"
- 4. Re-issue with list of comments and responses
- 5. No objections to the responses by the people raising the comments.

This process is now under way and will be complete by the time of the TMAG meeting. This will be confirmed at the meeting.

On this basis, we put forward the Test Data Strategy for formal approval by TMAG.

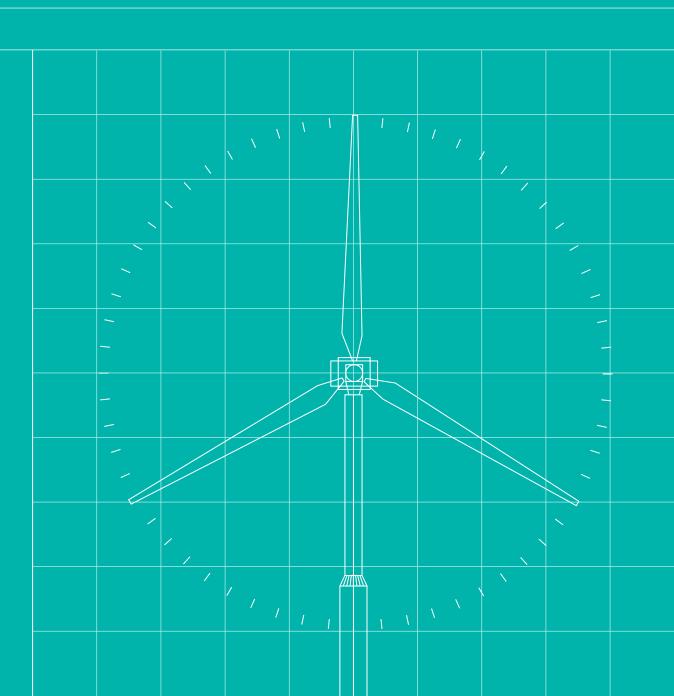

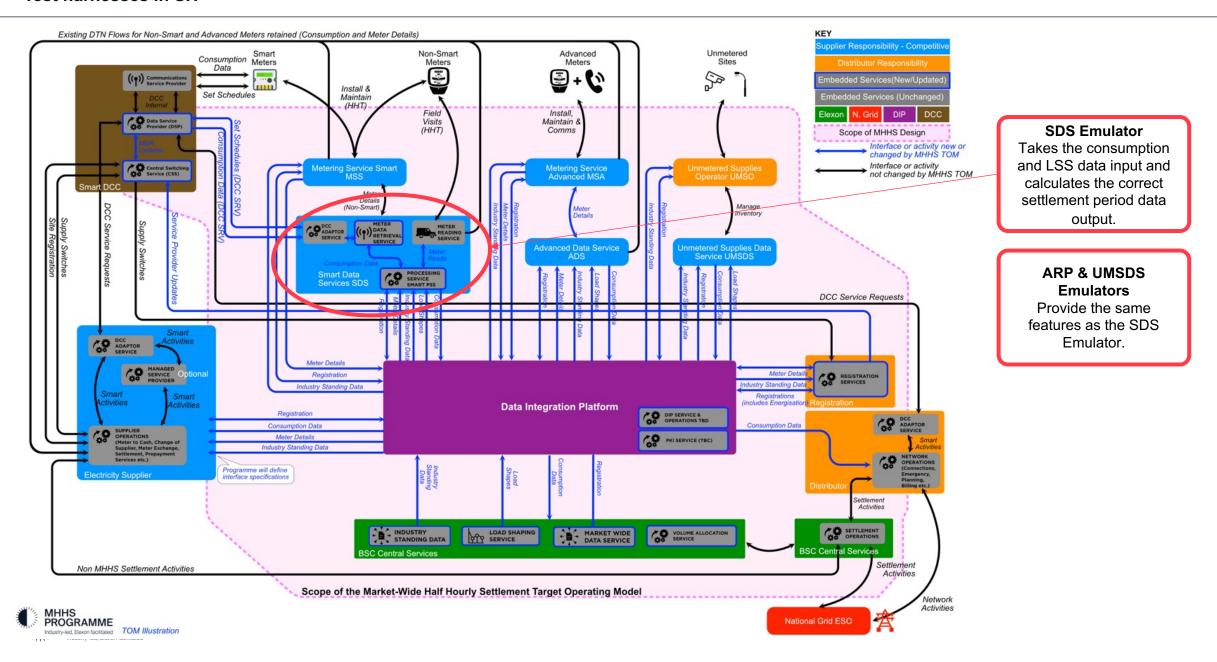




#### **Test harnesses in PIT**



#### **Test harnesses in SIT**

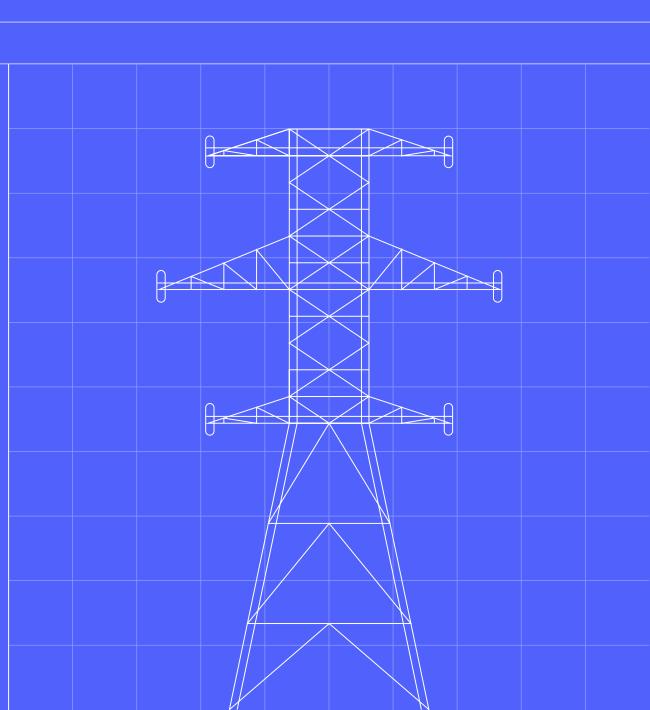

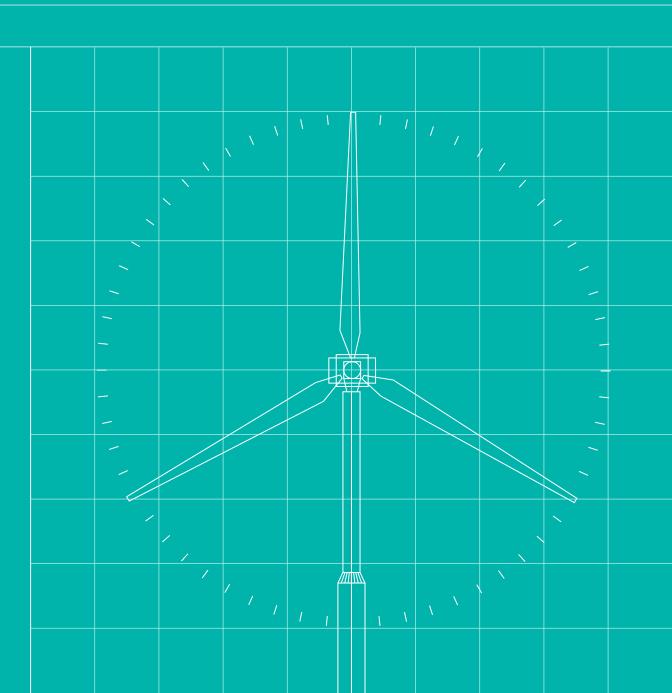


## Environments working group mobilisation

#### **Environments working group mobilisation**

We are proposing to establish the next level 4 working group.

The group will be called **Environments & Configuration Management Working Group (ECMWG)** and will have the role of helping to **define the Environments approach and plan** for the MHHS Programme and following the conclusion of its work recommend approval of the Environments plan to TMAG.

We are proposing the Group meets on the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of the month, with the first meeting being 05 July 2022. The group Terms of Reference will be reviewed at the first meeting to raise to TMAG for sign off.

We are establishing this group early as **the outcome of the environment plan will inform participants of the environments they will require** to participate in the testing and inform any internal planning necessary to ensure these environments are available in a timely manner.
